We are all looking forward to reviewing the plan with the public and hearing comments about our efforts and ideas,” concluded Mayor Stammel.

Rensselaer Rising is funded through an \$85,000 Brownfield Opportunity Area (BOA) grant from the New York State Department of State. While historically focused on brownfields, the program has evolved and now looks at opportunities for investment and revitalization of underutilized, abandoned, or vacant sites.
